



REQUEST FOR ADVANCE DEPOSIT HARDSHIP WAIVER
(Must file with a Request to Appeal Administrative Citation.)

Sonoma County Code Section 1-7.6(i) provides that any person who intends to contest an Administrative Citation and is financially unable to make the advance deposit of the fine as required by Section 1-7.6(f), may file a Request for Advance Deposit Hardship Waiver

A copy of this request must accompany a written Request to Appeal Administrative Citation and documentation* supporting financial hardship. Both requests and all supporting documents must be received by Permit Sonoma within thirty (30) days from date of the Administrative Citation

If your request is not granted, you must remit the advance deposit of your administrative citation fine to Permit Sonoma within seven (7) days of service of the decision. Failure to pay the deposit in a timely manner will result in a waiver of the right to a hearing.

If your Request for Advance Deposit Hardship Waiver is granted, then the advance deposit of your administrative citation fine is waived, and you will be notified of a hearing date.
